

Instruction for ERMP 2025 Exam

Dear ERMP 2025 Applicants:

- The MCQ exam will be given on **February 17, 2026 (TUESDAY)** at the respective exam hubs.
- Orientation **about the MCQ exam** and on how to **log-in** will be given on **February 16, 2026 (MONDAY)** starting from **9:00 am** at the respective exam hubs. **All applicants MUST attend the orientation.**
- Only those applicants whose name is listed in the list of eligible candidates for the 2025 ERMP exam are allowed to take the exam (list attached).
- Applicants can take the exam and login only based on their hub choice (indicated in the final list of eligible candidates).
- After the orientation all applicants should find out their names from the list posted on a hub board and **know the exact hall** where they will take their MCQ exam.
- All applicants should present at their respective exam hubs **@ 7:30 AM** so that the time for check-in and log-in will be adequate.
- All applicants MUST come with their **valid ID card** (kebele ID or passport or driving license or work place ID or bank book or any other valid ID) **with applicant's viewable photo on it**;
 - **NO APPLICANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER TO THE EXAM HALL WITHOUT ID.**

- Bags, note papers and electronic devices such as mobile phone, laptop, tablet, flash disk, smart watch ... etc are **NOT ALLOWED** to take to the exam hall. If found, an applicant will automatically be disqualified from the exam.
 - Please be informed that we will not take any responsibility for lost belongings.
- The ERMP exam contains 200 multiple choice questions (based on the blueprint, which is attached), divided into two parts.
- Part I exam of 100 questions will be conducted in the morning and Part II of another 100 questions in the afternoon
- Those of you who did not take the NGAT exam, you are obliged to take it as per the schedule of Ministry of Education, since the NGAT PASS certificate will be required during admission after matching.

NB.

Out of **3043** registered applicants, **2540** were found to have complete registration and confirmed. But, as it has been mentioned in the ERMP 2025 guideline, **68** applicants were found as **matched** last year during the 2024 ERMP, and thus are excluded from the list of eligibles this year (list attached).

One candidate was found with double registration and double submit, thus, he is disqualified from being eligible for the 2025 ERMP exam, and he is informed by phone.
